



Building Energy Reporting and Disclosure Ordinance | Boston, MA

The City of Boston has enacted the Building Energy Reporting and Disclosure Ordinance (BERDO). Starting in 2017 and every year thereafter, the ordinance requires large buildings to report their annual energy and water performance and greenhouse gas emissions to the City, which then makes the information publicly available. Additionally, every five years, buildings that are not already efficient must complete an energy assessment or action.

Tracking building energy use helps to reduce energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions. As a result, the energy reporting ordinance is helping Boston's building owners connect to opportunities for energy efficiency and helping cut energy costs.

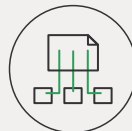
